# A reading from the letter of St James

How does it help, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but does not have works? Will faith save that person?

If one of the brothers or one of the sisters is in need of clothes and has not enough food to live on, and one of you says to them, 'Go in peace. Keep warm and eat plenty,' without giving them the bare necessities of life, what good is that?

In the same way faith: if good deeds do not go with it, it is quite dead by itself.

But someone may say, 'So you have faith and I have good deeds.'
Show me this faith of yours without deeds then, and I will show you faith by means of my deeds!

## A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark

Jesus and his disciples left for the villages round Caesarea Philippi. On the way he put a question to his disciples, saying to them,

'Who do people say I am?'

And they told him,

'John the Baptist, others Elijah, others again, one of the prophets.'

Then he himself put a further question to them,

'But you, who do you say I am?'

In answer Peter said,

'You are the Messiah.'

And he gave them strict orders not to tell anyone about him.

Then he began to teach them that the Son of man had to suffer much, and to be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes, and to be put to death, and after three days to rise again; and he said all this quite openly. Then, taking him aside, Peter began to rebuke him. But, turning and looking at his disciples, he rebuked Peter and said to him,

'Get behind me, Satan! You are thinking not as God thinks, but as humans do.'

He called together the crowd with his disciples and said to them,

'Anyone who wants to be a follower of mine

must renounce self and take up the cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save life will lose it:

but whoever loses life for my sake, and for the sake of the gospel, will save it.'
