Discovering the birth of Jesus in *St Paul* & the *4 Gospels* 

Q: What would we know about Jesus if we only had the letters of St Paul?



#### We learn very little about the historical Jesus through Paul

- 1. he was "born of a woman" (Galatians 4:4)
- 2. he was Jewish, "born under the law" (Galatians 4:4)
- 3. a biological descendant of David (Romans 1:3)
- 4. he had brothers (1 Corinthians 9:5)
- 5. he was crucified (1 Corinthians 1:22) and he died (1 Corinthians 15:3)



#### Gospel of Mark

Tells us nothing of the birth of Jesus (begins with the public ministry of Jesus)

Called a 'narrative of omission'



#### Gospel of John

Begins with spiritual and divine prologue Jn 1:14 –

"And the word became flesh and dwelt among us"



#### Gospel of Matthew

2 chapters
Elaborate genealogy of 42 generations
Joseph's perspective as 'just man'
Centred on the holy family's home in Bethlehem
Includes Magoi & escape to Egypt



#### Gospel of Luke

2 chapters
Gentile audience – marginalised and neglected
Emphasises poor family on the move
Shepherds are key witnesses
